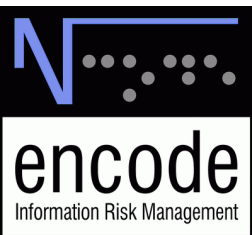

## **PROFESSOR IAN ANGELL**

**Emeritus Professor of Information Systems, London School of Economics and Political Science**

- ▶ Ian Angell has been Professor of Information Systems at the London School of Economics since 1986. Prior to that he researched and taught computer science at Royal Holloway College and University College London. Angell has very radical yet constructive views on his subject and is very critical of what he calls "the pseudo-science of academic information systems."
- ▶ He has gained a certain notoriety worldwide for his aggressive polemics against the inappropriate use of artificial intelligence and so-called knowledge management, and against the hyperbole surrounding 'e-commerce'. Professor Angell's growing reputation comes as the culmination of twenty years work developing a new perspective on information systems, which stresses that the social, economic and organizational issues are more important than the technological ones: even the very best investment in new technology can be a source of commercial risk, if the societal aspects are not managed properly.
- ▶ Professor Angell acts as a consultant on the management, security and strategic impact of information systems, to many national and international organizations and to a number of governments and the EU. Undoubtedly it is Angell's radical and controversial views on the global consequences of IT that has brought him such a high-profile Reputation as a 'futurologist' in business circles and in the media.
- ▶ Angell has published ten books on computer graphics. January 2000 saw the publication of his book *The New Barbarian Manifesto*, in which he lays out his advice on how to win in an increasingly complex, brutal and brutish world. This book is having an impact worldwide. His latest book, jointly authored with his friend and colleague Dionysios Demetis, *Science's First Mistake*, looks at the financial markets. He has produced a new edition of *The New Barbarian Manifesto*, *The Flight of the Golden Geese*, that focuses on taxation.

## **EMMANOUIL SFAKIANAKIS**

### **Police Major General, Head of the Hellenic Police, Cyber Crime Division**

- ▶ Police Major General Emmanouil Sfakianakis is the Head of the Hellenic Police/Cyber Crime Division. He joined the Police Force 33 years ago, 21 of which are dedicated to the investigation of electronic crimes. He leads the Electronic Crime of the Hellenic Police since 1995 when he started alone as one-man-team, on 2004 the Cyber Crime Unit was established and till today it has been promoted to Cyber Crime Division commanded by him all the time. He studied computer analysis and programming, has been trained in London on crime concerning counterfeit currency (Plastic Crime) and he has been trained by the FBI on matters regarding terrorism over the internet (Cyber Terrorism).
- ▶ During his long-term career in the Hellenic Police, he has handled more than 8.500 cases involving serious cybercrime till 2015. He has participated as a keynote speaker from year 2001 to 2015 in 851 national and International conferences of INTERPOL - EUROPOL - Universities - international organizations – multinational companies etc. He has organized up-to-date meetings via teleconferencing in 5.140 educational institutions of our country from October 2014 till February 2015, as well as and 218 workshops in various cities in Greece concerning the SAFE INTERNET initiative.
- ▶ In 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015 he organized, as Head of the Hellenic Police/Cyber Crime, the Conferences that were held for the World Day of the Internet and had international reach. He is also a Professor for the Police Academy and the Officers' Post Training School of the Hellenic Police. He participates in the Post-Graduate Program in Criminal Sciences of Athens Law School from which he will graduate within 2015 by achieving the Master's Degrees in Criminal Science and Criminology studies. He is the author of two books: 1) Internet addiction (Livani Publications, 2012) and 2) E-crime and Punishment (scheduled to be issued in June, 2015).

- ▶ Police Major General Emmanouil Sfakianakis has been awarded, till 2015, 81 honor titles and accolades from:

  - 3) The Minister of Finance for combating cyber crime in our country, as well as the best Manager for Public Service

He has participated in two road trips from Athens, Greece to Beijing, China and from Athens to Cape Town, South Africa with the aim of filming renewable energy sources and bioclimatic architectural designs along the way.
- ▶ He has been invited to give talks on science communication in Tel Aviv, Bangkok, Seoul, Istanbul, Tokyo, Melbourne and Greece. In July 2010, Theodore was selected and participated in NASA Spacecamp training regarding space science.
- ▶ He has made several special appearances on Greek Television and is featured in numerous publications in the Greek and International press.
- ▶ He is the host and presenter of TEDxAthens since 2011.
